How do I donate?

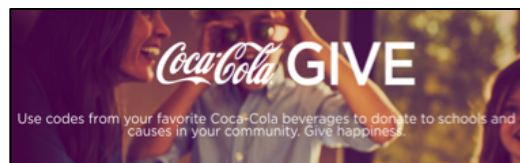
Go to Coke.com/give to sign-up and donate any Coca-Cola beverage's product code. You'll find it under the cap or printed within the multi-pack.
