1. Spring CBM Data

SCC looked over fall, winter, and spring data. 4th and 5th grade made great gains in SRI data. 2nd, 4th, and 5th met their goals on spring mcomp. 4th and 5th met their goals on mcap. All grades aim for 80% or higher proficient on both assessments. Brief discussion on SAGE—4th and 5th grade did as well or better than last year. Our Language Arts scores may increase due to a scoring glitch.

2. Sunrise Behavior Report - End of Year Summary

Sunrise Eagles earned 31,034 Something to Celebrates this year. There were 181 Office Discipline Referrals—with the majority, 39, occurring in May. Aggression and insubordination are the most common offenses. The majority of offenses happen on the playground and in the classroom. We had 65 incidents where students met the threshold for documenting unexcused absences.

3. SNAP - Feedback from the district

SCC looked over the document from the district regarding our SNAP plan. Sandy responded to our concerns that they will be evaluated when funding becomes available or redevelopment occurs. Salt Lake County said that our concern is in their zone that they are applying for UDOT money to improve that area. Parents can find our SNAP plan on Sunrise's website—in the parent/guardian handbook.

4. 5th Grade Keyboarding Results

Sunrise's 5th grade had the second highest score in the district. We had 39% of our 5th graders proficient. 39% is a 23% increase from last year. Our Land Trust keyboarding aide has done a fantastic job teaching keyboarding skills. We would like to have 80% of our 5th graders proficient next year.

5. Budgets

We have spent all but \$400 of our Land Trust Budget. Cell Tower currently has \$236 left.
