Welcome – Those in attendance were recognized and thanked for taking time out of their schedules to be there. A motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting was made by Pam Gassman. A second was made by Ms. Swanicke and the minutes were unanimously approved.

1 – SOARing Sunrise News - Ms. Swanicke will send out a link to parents of our SOARing Sunrise News soon.

2 – Sunrise SCC website – All Sunrise SCC agendas and minutes will be posted on the Sunrise Elementary School website. The agenda will be posted one week prior to upcoming meetings and minutes will be posted within one week after the meeting

3 – Review current CSIP- Ms. Swanicke handed out the current CSIP plan which was discussed briefly. See CSIP 2016-2017 for details.

4 – Final Report – Report is turned in. Ms. Swanicke didn't report the amendment on the state website which generated some comments in the narrative.

5- Digital Citizenship – Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship is a responsibility for the SCC. "The intent is to involve SCCs in an ongoing discussion about creating a safe technology environment for students in public school." pg. 39 of the 2016-2017 SSC Handbook. Pg. 44 was reviewed and discussed as a council. Ms. Swanicke updated the SCC on what Sunrise is doing to keep students digitally safe. Hilary Christensen is the Internet Safety Coordinator for Sunrise. She holds trainings for faculty and sends out a monthly internet safety email. It was discussed that by logging on to the canyonair wifi, SCC members were able access Facebook and other social media. Facebook was not accessible using the CSDGuest wifi which is what guests should use. Facebook, Instagram, Tumblr and YouTube should all be blocked to Elementary School students using canyonair wi-fi. Marc Hone recommended proper filtering on all wi-fi. Ms. Swanicke is following up with Sunrise's Ed and Field Tech to resolve this concern about canyonair.

6- Land Trust Plan parent communication plan – A copy of the Sunrise Elementary School End of Year Land Trust Summary Report was reviewed. It was noted that Sunrise was able to spend \$46,119 of Land Trust funds on our students during the 2015-2016 school year. A thorough summary of how that money was spent and how it benefits each Sunrise student is included in the report. Ms. Swanicke also mentioned the School Digger rank improvement of Sunrise over the last 3 years and credited the faculty for their hard work and dedication to the students at Sunrise. A PDF of this report will be sent to parents/guardians once a year.

7 – Cell Tower Budget – There is \$4,852 remaining in the Cell Tower budget.

8 – Land Trust Budget – Of the \$44,381 which was received for 2016-2017, \$41,922.78 is remaining. The budget report was reviewed.

9 – Input from the Community if any other parents are present---No additional members from the community were present.
