


Sunrise Elementary School Community Council was pleased to be able to spend \$65,674 of LAND Trust funds on Sunrise Eagles for the 2018 - 19 school year.

\$65,674 of LAND Trust funds on Sunrise Eagles for the 2018 - 19 school year. It was determined that funds should be spent on reading, math, and technology. To increase reading and math achievement, students were identified as performing below benchmark on Acadience testing. Students identified received daily intervention support from intervention assistants under the direction of the achievement coach. Most of the allocated School Land Trust funding, \$37,750, was used to hire three assistants to provide reading interventions and two assistants to provide math interventions. Sunrise SCC values teaching 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders keyboarding skills. It was decided to spend, \$7,550, on an assistant to teach keyboarding skills. A total of \$15,720 was spent on Chromebooks and iPads. Sunrise 4th and 5th grade teachers requested English Language Arts materials to help their writing instruction which cost \$4,653. The Sunrise SCC sees our LAND Trust Plan resources as a crucial component of our student achievement. It also helps that Sunrise teachers are simply the BEST!

## Sunrise's Teacher Student Success Plan Goals for 2019 - 2020

#### **ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS**

- 70% of 3rd grade students will achieve proficient on RISE Language Arts
  - 70.6% 2018 2019 RISE
- 80% of 4th grade students will achieve proficient on RISE Language Arts
  - 91% 2018 2019 RISE
- 80% of 5th grade students will achieve proficient on RISE Language Arts
  - 69% 2018 2019 RISE
- 100% of 3rd 5th grade SALTA students will achieve proficient or highly proficient on RISE Language Arts
  - 100% 2018 2019 RISE

#### **MATHEMATICS**

- 77% of 3rd grade students will achieve proficient on RISE Mathematics
  - 72.6% 2018 2019 RISE
- 83% of 4th grade students will achieve proficient on RISE Mathematics
  - 91.3% 2018 2019 RISE
- 83% of 5th grade students will achieve proficient on RISE Mathematics
  - 70.6% 2018 2019 RISE
- 100% of 3rd 5th grade SALTA students will achieve proficient or highly proficient on SAGE Mathematics
  - 98.6% 2018 2019 RISE
