We are so excited to meet you this fall! Here are some of the skills and tasks we would like students to work on over the summer to be prepared for second grade.

Language Arts

Read aloud to an adult for at least ten minutes a day.

Identify consonants and vowels, and sort them accordingly.

Read basic short vowel words and long vowel words.

Read words with blends (bl, cl, mp, etc.) and digraphs (sh, ch, th, etc).

Do 30 minutes of Lexia per week.

Writing

Write complete sentences using describing words.

Use correct capitalization and punctuation in your sentences.

MATH

Add and subtract fluently within 20.

Identify coins, and know their value.

Tell time to the hour and half hour.

Skip count by 2's, 5's, and 10's, starting at any number.

Count backward from any number between 0 and 50

Do 30 minutes of i-Ready Math per week.




